On line applications are invited for admission to following Post–Graduate Programme:

- 1. M. Sc Chemistry (2 Year Programme): Department of Chemistry
- 2. M. Sc Physics (2 Year Programme): Department of Physics

The admission is only for the unfilled seats remaining, after the National Spot Round (NSR) conducted by CCMN-2022 coordinated by MNIT Jaipur. The Institute level examination will be conducted to fill up the vacant seats after NSR of CCMN-2022, as per the guidelines of the Institute.

In case all seats are filled through CCMN-2022, then Institute cannot admit any of the candidates.

Eligibility:

The basic eligibility criteria for qualifying degree will be as per CCMN-2022 which is as follows:

In qualifying degree, the candidates should have passed and secured at least 6.5 CGPA (on a10-point scale) or 60% for GEN/GEN-EWS/OBC, whereas 6.0 CGPA (on a 10-point scale) or 55% in case of SC/ST/PwD candidates. The above mentioned CGPA/percentage should be awarded by a recognized University/Institute.

Only primary mode of evaluation (CGPA or percentage) as mentioned in the qualifying degree certificate / marks sheet shall be considered while verifying eligibility.

The relevant degrees to be considered for determining the eligibility will be strictly as per the CCMN 2022 Guidelines.

Pattern of Examination: The question paper will consist of 60 MCQ type questions of maximum marks 60. Each correct answer will carry 1 (One) mark and for wrong answer, 0.25 mark will be deducted. Questions not attempted will result in zero mark. The duration of exam will be of 90 minutes.

Application submission:

The candidates have to apply online using the link https://admission.nitsri.ac.in/.

Candidates are required to pay application processing fee per specialization of Rs: 100/- (Rs One Hundred Only) through online mode at the time of submitting on–line applications.

At the time of entrance examination; Rs 1400/- (One Thousand and Four Hundred only) for General/OBC-NCL and Rs.650 (Rs Six Hundred and Fifty Only) for SC/ST/EWS/PwD has to be submitted in the form of a Demand Draft in favour of "DIRECTOR NIT SRINAGAR." Without Demand Draft, the candidate will not be allowed to sit in the entrance examination.

Applications will be screened by concerned Departments and list of eligible candidates will be available on Institute website: www.nitsri.ac.in. All announcements related to admissions will be made through our website. All candidates are advised to keep in touch with the Institute website till the process of enrolment is complete.

The selection will be provisional subject to the verification of the all the documents in original and fulfillment of requirements as per the statutes and advertisement.

They should enter 00 in the Percentage/CGPA field. They should also upload the complete transcript of marks / grade up to last but one semester / year.
