NIT/Non-Teaching/2020/5(NT) dated 22nd October 2020, that the Institute is in the process of finalizing the non-teaching recruitment. The Institute in view of various guidelines/ orders issued by the Govt. of India has finalized the following scheme for Selection / Recruitment Test shown against each post/group of posts.

	2. PART B shall consist of the 50% questions separately from various branches of engineering mentioned in the eligibility conditions as per the advertisement. The candidate shall have to attempt any set of questions in this part as per his qualification only. No candidate shall be allowed to attempt questions mixing from other streams in the question paper.
	3. The candidate shall have to qualify both the parts separately.
	Minimum qualifying marks shall be 30% from each part.
	4. The merit shall be prepared for only those candidates who qualify both the parts separately. The merit shall be prepared based on the score obtained in both the parts.
	5. The question paper shall of the level of the B. Tech and M.Sc Physics level.

	preparing a common merit of candidates across all streams category wise.
	Candidates securing highest marks in the selection process across the
	category and all departments/sections may be recommended for selection in
	such a manner that each department/section gets at least one position. For
	allocating the finally recommended candidates to the departments/centres
	following scheme shall be followed:
	1. First, 01 candidate in ST category securing highest marks shall be
	placed in the Department/Section as per the basic eligibility required
	for that department. No further selection from any category shall be
	made for such department/section.
	2. Then 01 candidate belonging to SC category securing highest marks
	from the department other than the one where ST candidate in point
	1 above has been selected, shall be placed in the
	Department/Section as per the basic eligibility required for that
	department. No further selection from any category shall be made

Then 03 candidates belonging to OBC category securing highest marks from the department other than those where ST, SC & EWS candidates in point 1, 2 & 3 above have been selected, shall be placed in the Department/Section as per the basic eligibility required for that department. No further selection from any category shall be made for such department/section.
- 5. Finally, 08 UR candidates securing highest marks from the department other than those where ST, SC, EWS& OBC candidates in point 1, 2, 3 & 4 above have been selected, shall be placed in the Department/Section as per the basic eligibility required for that department.

The selection for this post is on the basis of written test. Following shall be the structure of the selection test:

- 1. 1st written test shall be more of general nature. The candidates shall be screened in the ratio of 1:15 in this test. Minimum qualifying marks for UR category shall be 30%, for OBC & EWS shall be 27% and for SC/ST shall be 20% and that for PwD shall be 15%.
- 2. Skill test shall be held for those candidates who qualify the 1st written test. The candidate shall have to score minimum 50% to qualify the Skill Test. Skill test shall be of qualifying nature only.
- 3. 2nd written test shall be held for the candidates who qualify the skill test. This test shall be subject specific. Minimum qualifying marks for UR category shall be 30%, for OBC & EWS shall be 27% and for SC/ST shall be 20% and that for PwD shall be 15%.
- 4. The merit shall be drawn giving 30% weightage to the score obtained in the 1st written test and 70% weightage to the score obtained in the 2nd written test.
