A student can have a maximum of two exits during the entire programme obviously rejoining with a gap (not less than two academic semesters) after each exit. If a candidate wants to rejoin within a gap of less than two academic semesters he/ she has to surrender the already issued certificate/ Diploma. The maximum duration for completing B.Tech. programme including the gap between exit and rejoining should not be more than 8 (Eight) years.

(b). Multiple Exit Policy : M.Tech./ M.Sc. Programme (2 Year Duration):

A single intermediate exit point as shown below has been adopted by NIT Srinagar. Also the maximum duration of completion of programme should be 5 years for the students who have taken an intermediate exit and rejoined for acquiring the substantive M.Tech./M.Sc. degree.

2. Creation of Academic bank of credits (ABC) in NAD (National Academic Depository)

From 2022 B.Tech. admission batch the students are being registered on ABC and their ABC IDs have been generated. For previous batches the degree certificates of B.Tech pass out batches of 2018,2019 and 2020 have been uploaded in NAD.

3. Accessibility

Most of the infrastructure (buildings, etc.) at the Institute has been made friendly for differently abled persons by way of provision of ramps and lifts.

4. Ph.D. Regulations

Various activities of counselling Cell: -

1) Teams of volunteers: -

The students are more comfortable discussing the problem in the same age group. So teams of volunteers from the students have been formed. These volunteers are trained every 15 days to deal with the issues of students.

2) Workshop on “How to manage stress”.

On 20th May 2019, a workshop on "How to manage stress" organized by Counseling Cell NIT Srinagar. The workshop was conducted by the Institute Counselor Mr. Fairouz and Mr. Hussain, mental health therapist. The session was coordinated by Dr. Neeraj Gupta, Assistant Professor, Department of Electrical Engineering. The counselors started with defining stress, its causes, effect on life. Various activities were conducted like relaxation exercises, free association, mindfulness and deep breathing to relieve stress. Additionally, Mr. Shankar, head of ADANI automation, shared his life experiences and motivated students towards study.

3) Teams of student volunteers for the new batch of students (2019):

To help the new batch of students to cope with stress, teams of student volunteers have been set up to deal with **Academic related issues** (Low self-confidence, Decisions regarding career, Time management), **Emotional stress** (Problems related to peers, Relationships, Family Issues, Adjusting to the new environment, Homesickness, Sleep disorders, Loneliness, Anxiety).

4) Banners displayed on campus by Counseling cell:

Banners with phone numbers of counselors and student volunteers are displayed at various locations on the campus so that any stress-related issues can be reported and resolved.

5) Frequent Visits to Hostel for awareness programs.

Another initiative was taken according to the instructions given by the Honorable Director to visit Hostels of the institute with the sole aim to aware students about fundamental Mental health issues and the impact of such issues on quality of life; and also to promote open discussions on Mental health problems and positive mental wellbeing. Accordingly, visits are often paid to the hostels and students are made aware of the mental health and stress management techniques. The counseling cell and Medical Unit is working hard to provide primary health care, awareness programs and psycho-social support to Students of the institution.

The students are more comfortable discussing the problem in the same age group. So teams of volunteers from the students have been formed. These volunteers are trained every 15 days to deal with the issues of students.

2) Workshop on “How to manage stress”.

On 20th May 2019, a workshop on "How to manage stress" organized by Counseling Cell NIT Srinagar. 
